CARE PLAN 2.0

In 2.0, clients can have care plans in draft, completed, or archived status in addition to their current active care plan.


From the Care Plan tab, click View on the care plan you wish to review or select +Add Care Plan to create a new one.

ADDING CARE PLAN ITEMS


NOTE: You must publish a Care Plan for it to become active and for interventions and goals to flow through the service tasks for a scheduled visit

CARE PLAN 1.0



As interventions are the equivalent of Daily Activities in 2.0, the Daily Activities tab under Care Documentation has been removed.

CARE PLAN 2.0



Care Plan 2.0 allows you to add more details about diagnoses, goals and interventions - i.e., progress tracking method for goals, frequencies for interventions






Once you have created a new care plan library, you can add diagnoses, goals, and interventions in the same way you add items to a client care plan.











ADDING CARE PLAN ITEMS FROM A LIBRARY



When adding items from a library, you can add all library items, all library items of one type (diagnoses, goals or interventions), or individual items from the library (with or without any items that may be linked to them).

NOTE: You must publish a care plan library before it will become available to select from when building client care plans







REVIEWING AND ADDING SERVICE TASKS ON WEB

NOTE: You cannot edit interventions when creating recurrences


Service Tasks consist of Interventions and Goals from a Care Plan and Forms attached to the visit or Service

COMPLETING SERVICE TASKS ON WEB

NOTE: You can add additional forms or interventions from the client's care plan to the service tasks of a visit

Since interventions are replacing daily activities, there is no longer a Daily Activities tab in the visit dialogue in 2.0. Instead, there is a Service Tasks tab.

Once you clock in to a visit, you can mark interventions and goals as complete or leave a comment if they cannot be completed. You can also complete any forms that appear in service tasks.
